The nature of God

There are 5 characteristics of God which set Him apart from any other being in the universe:

1. God is Eternal - He is without beginning or end

Psalm 90:2 (569) Revelation 1:8 (1174)

2. God is everywhere present (He is never "out of range")

1 Kings 8:27 (328) Psalm 139:7-9 (597) Jeremiah 23:23, 24 (754) Hebrews 4:13 (1150)

3. God knows everything - past, present and future

Proverbs 15:3 (617) Isaiah 40:28 (694) Acts 15:18 (1068) Romans 11:33 (1094)

4. God is able to accomplish what He wills - nothing is too hard for Him

5. God is unchangeable - God is perfect, He cannot change for better or for worse. He can never be greater or more holy than He is, nor can He be less so.

He wants people to turn to Him and live, not be destroyed Ezekiel 18:30-32 (818)
